LILYFIELD QUARRY INC. WELL INVENTORY PROGRAM

Lilyfield Quarry Inc. (LQI) and Hugh Munro Construction Ltd. (HMCL) are committed to completing a comprehensive well inventory of all wells within proximity of the proposed Lilyfield Quarry site for those who agree to participate in the well inventory program. As part of our agreement with the RM of Rosser, we are required to offer residents in the area an inventory of private and domestic water wells lying within the area. Lilyfield Quarry Inc. is not expected to permanently change the quantity of groundwater available in the local aquifer system, and the potential drawdown at the site would likely be within the range of seasonal water fluctuations. Based on the information available, the potential impacts of the quarry operations on nearby water wells and offsite groundwater system overall, is considered minimal.

The purpose of the well inventory is to assess the condition of private water wells and the aquifer surrounding the proposed quarry site, prior to the starting of the quarry. In this way, if a private water well is damaged or impacted from the quarry operation, Lilyfield Quarry Inc. will repair or replace the well at no charge to the land owner. The well inventory program will document any existing issues with wells and provide the baseline data for continued monitoring. Lilyfield Quarry Inc. shall file the well study and report with the Municipality for its review.

The well inventory shall be conducted by Friesen Drillers Limited, who is an independent third-party contractor to LQI/HMCL. Friesen Drillers will be contacting each resident shortly to arrange for a time to participate in the inventory. The inventory would involve an appointment of about 15 to 20 minutes for each resident. The well would be GPS located, and the provincial water well record would be matched to the specific well. The general condition of each well would be determined, along with the method and style of well hook up/pump connection. Finally, a routine groundwater quality sample would be collected, along with a bacteria sample. The water well would not be inspected downhole. Nothing would be removed from the well during the inspection.

It is important that all residents living within the agreed radius of the proposed quarry take part in the inventory. A second round of letters are being sent out to RM of Rosser residents that were not included in the first round. We will require your response to the acceptance of the well inventory program by October 19, 2020. A resident may decide not to participate in the program. If that is your choice no future claims will be able to be submitted to LQI/HMCL. If there is no response by October 19, 2020, we will deem that you are not interested in the well program and no future claims can be submitted or accepted.
